The Security Knowledge and Skill Development Council is a CAPSI-National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) initiative to enhance the security skills of already employed security guards and also developing special security skills for the youth taking up private security as employment all over the country.

The Security Knowledge & Skill Development Council is being formed to achieve the following objectives:

1. Identify the skill gaps at each level and develop course curriculum, training programmes and training manuals accordingly.
2. Setting of National Standards, Bench Marks and Testing for each level and trades in private security.
3. Plan and execute 'Training of Trainers' for each level and trade in private security.
4. Identification, selection and accreditation providers in private security across the country and promoting them as Centres of Excellence.
5. Creating a nationwide data base of trained manpower in private security.
6. Carry out research to identify future requirements in training and skill development.
7. Monitoring and auditing the quality of security training providers.
8. Create a specially skilled workforce in Private Security Sector (PSS) with specialisation at each level and trade.
9. Constituting an Examination Board for the conduct of Examination and Certification for different levels of courses to include certificate and diplomas.
